

# Assistance Required - calling all Surf Clubs



Dear Surf Club,

As you gear up for a new summer season 2011-12, we too are beginning a new phase.

From August 2011, we will be assisting an initial five Indigenous communities from remote Australia to gain new life skill qualifications (Senior First Aid, CPR & Bronze Medallion), become more water confident and lead more active, safe & healthy lives in and around the water systems where they live which include rivers, weirs, dams as well as the local pool.

In order to do this as well as possible, we are calling for some assistance from any member or Club who can help with;

- 1) **Any old rescue gear or surf sports equipment that can be used for training and demonstration.** (Nipper Paddle Boards, Rescue Boards, Racing Mals, Skis, soft boards, SUP, Paddles, Old Belt & Reel, RescueTubes, Water Safety uniforms, flags, buoys, poles, Pool Rescue gear Resuscitation Manikins, First Aid Kits, Obstacles, Ropes, Cans, old trailer?)
- 2) **Establishing a sister club / community network with one of the Communities.**  
Heading south from the Qld border we will be working initially with the five communities of Mungindi, Goodooga, Walgett, Coonamble and Gulargambone.  
Selected members from these communities will be coming to the Gold Coast in February 2012 for a taste of surf club life and to experience a smorgasbord of aquatic activities including a local surf carnival, surfing lessons, training for their Bronze Medallion.  
The ultimate plan is to get local surf clubs to adopt a community (like Currumbin & Coonamble) and offer an **exchange program** where they can come and visit the coast for a few days a year and our young local lifesavers can visit their community each year for valuable experience.  
Young Mariah Jones of TH&C has been earmarked as the Ambassador for this Bush to Beach Program and down the track we propose to help these communities to be able to conduct a six week basic "Bush Nippers" program over the Summer School holidays.

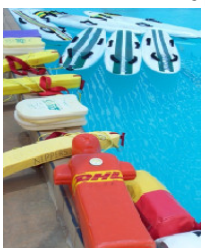
